Essential Guidelines for E-Learning, Final Evaluation, and Getting Certified

Following these guidelines will ensure a smooth e-learning experience and help you successfully complete your final evaluation and certification.

- 1. Engage with the Course Material:
 - Watch and learn from the self-paced videos for each of the 11 chapters.
- 2. Navigate Using Course Index:
 - Use the course index tab to browse through the available chapters and review questions.
- 3. Chapter Review Questions:
 - After each chapter, you will encounter review questions. It is mandatory to attempt and pass these questions with minimum grades to progress to the next chapter.
 - Unlimited attempts are allowed for these review questions.
- 4. Final Evaluation Preparation:
 - Upon completing all chapters and review questions, you will need to attempt a Final Evaluation consisting of 50 multiple-choice questions. A passing score requires at least 35 correct answers.
- 5. Safe Exam Browser Download:
 - Before the Final Evaluation, download the Safe Exam Browser by clicking the following link: https://safeexambrowser.org/download_en.html. The Safe Exam Browser will restrict your access to other browser tabs and applications during the exam. This ensures compliance with test Terms and Conditions and ActiCert's academic integrity policy. Please ensure that no other applications are running and that you do not attempt to navigate away from the exam window. (Detailed steps are given below)
- 6. Final Evaluation:
 - You have 50 minutes to complete the Final Evaluation and only 2 attempts to pass.

- 7. Course Timeline:
 - You can learn at your own pace, but you must complete the course within 30 days from registration. If you do not complete the course within this timeframe, you will need to contact ActiCert Support to renew the course for a fee of CA\$ 20 plus taxes.
- 8. Test Results and Certification:
 - Test results are provided immediately on the portal upon completion. You will also receive the final certificate via email.
